

the first half is on reasonable paths or roadways — fine for a Sunday stroll. The second part crosses fields so needs stouter footwear and is for the more adventurous.

> ark in Strode Road, in Clevedon, and walk down and turn right onto the footpath running alongside the Blind Yeo. The golf course is over the other side of the river.

At the end, turn left onto the track. Keep on this track, which runs through the golf course, out onto the seafront to stunning views of the estuary. You will see Steephom, Flatholm,

Woodspring Priory, Cardiff and Chepstow.

Continue along the front with views of Clevedon behind you until a footpath branches off to the left onto a track. The track comes out onto a lane. Turn right onto the road and continue south with views of pastureland and hedgerow flora.

As the road takes a sharp right turn you will see the next footpath to take on the left, just beyond the gate.

Over the bridge into the field, go over a stile into another field. Head to the far right-hand corner through to a field with a rhyne running along the right edge. Turn left and head towards the farm houses. When you reach the bridge turn left and head back north towards Clevedon.

Enter and leave the next fields over stiles and then follow the hedge around to the right until you reach a farm track. Continue along it into the field ahead, off the track.

At the end of the field turn left. over the stile and follow the hedge line (the farm buildings are to the left) through a rougher, bumpier patch of land. Ahead is another stile and the footpath continues through a garden. Please treat it with respect.

The path comes out onto a track, turn right. At its end turn right on to the lane and continue along until you cross the bridge and return to the start.
